## ROBERT STILIN

Every design of Robert Stilin's—ultra-trad or way mod—is about creating a lifestyle. "At the end of the day, I want to provide a sanctuary that's comfortable and relaxing," explains the Montauk designer. He redoubled his comfort impulse in this living room, going for "a little bit of a loungy look" to contrast with the architecture's formality. A pair of '50s-vintage French chairs by the fireplace hug the ground like campers hunkered by a bonfire. A vintage Boujad kilim rug adds extra softness atop Tamarian's Tusken lamb striped carpet. Bold contemporary art floats unexpectedly from the chair rail. Furniture is sculptural, but padded. Monochromatic upholsteries allow the lavender walls—"which clients won't commit to"—to soothe.
